4 Secure it: Put an elastic band around the box. If it is for a specific gender or age range, please add a note under the elastic band.

5 Drop off in the Narthex at Our Lady Star of the Sea, **before 29<sup>th</sup> June.**

**Hygiene:** Toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, shower gel or soap, wet wipes, hairbrush or comb.

**Clothing:** Socks, gloves.

**Treats:** Chocolate, biscuits, dry snacks, individually wrapped sweets, herbal tea, hot chocolate powder.
