<u>CAFOD</u>: Our Parish Family Fast Day is Friday 14th March, a day when we are asked to eat simply and give generously to support families around the world. Your small act of love will make a big difference to many communities affected by extreme hunger and children suffering from malnutrition. Even more crucial with the Government deciding to cut the aid programme.

We will give out Fast Day envelopes on Saturday 8th March evening and Sunday 9th March morning mass and collect them Saturday 15th and Sunday 16th March. You can also give directly to cafod.org.uk

Cafod Stations of the Cross and Lenten lunches during Lent – from Friday 7th March Lenten lunches are back! Each Friday of Lent, after the 11:00am Mass and Stations of the Cross, you are warmly invited to come together and have a light Lenten lunch, usually soup, French bread or cheese; and give whatever you can to help those who are hungry. They would think this light meal a sumptuous feast!

Cafod Walk Against Hunger Lent challenge - Challenge yourself to walk 200k this Lent and help stamp out hunger, one step at a time. You can walk, roll, skip or stroll your way to 200k. You can boldly go it alone and take it on 5k a day for 40 days, or you can smash the target all at once as a team.
