SYNOD 2023: In January we will have an opportunity to share our views, if we wish, on three areas of the Church's life that Pope Francis is inviting us to consider so that he can discern what God is saying to us here and now. Our parish involvement is likely to be mainly via conversations in groups, entirely voluntary, meeting from 10:00am to 11:30am on two more successive Saturdays: 15th January and 22nd January; venues to be decided. Each session will invite responses to a number of statements in the following areas: session two; January 15th: Participation and Session three; January 22nd: Mission. If you would like to participate in some or all of these sessions, please let me know. The Clergy Team will not participate in the group meetings - we want them to be cleric-free - but we need to know how many groups to expect.
